Classes for TESOL and ESL training are currently held in this spacious facility with many large windows. This training facility is immediately adjacent to the Staff House and offers convenient but separate and private access for both students and teachers.



The first TESOL class started August 4, 2007. Small class size ensures close student/teacher contact throughout this one month intensive training program. Students receive an internationally recognized TESOL Certificate which qualifies them to teach English in any country. TESOL classes are offered each quarter or as demand warrants.



Teachers stay in a private, comfortable western style Staff House where meals are served three times a day. Every effort is made to make our guests feel right at home in a family setting.

The Staff House is located in a quiet neighborhood close to Cure Hospital and the American University. Great views, a large garden with green lawns and easy access to the city center make this an ideal location to live and work.

The Staff House is separate from, but adjacent to the School Buildings where classes are held. All buildings are surrounded with high walls topped with security fence to meet UN operational security standards for Afghanistan. Telephone and internet access are available.
